Hebrews 11:27-29

**By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king: for he endured, as seeing him who is invisible.** <sup>28</sup> Through faith he kept the passover, and the sprinkling of blood, lest he that destroyed the firstborn should touch them. <sup>29</sup> By faith they passed through the Red sea as by dry *land*: which the Egyptians assaying to do were drowned.

➤ **Listening to God**

Hear, O my people, and I will testify unto thee: O Israel, if thou wilt hearken unto me;

James chapter 1

Proverbs 8:32- Now therefore hearken unto me, o ye children: for blessed are they that keep my ways.

Isaiah 51:1- Hearken to me, ye that follow after righteousness, ye that seek the Lord:

look unto the rock whence ye are hewn,  
and to the hole of the pit whence ye are digged

➤ **Worshipping only one God**

there shall no strange god be in thee; neither shalt thou worship any strange god.

**Exodus 20:1-6**

➤ **Expecting and anticipating from God**

I *am* the LORD thy God, which brought thee out of the land of Egypt:  
open thy mouth wide, and I will fill it

**Deuteronomy 6:4; 2 Corinthians 9:8**

➤ **Walking in His blessing daily**

<sup>11</sup> But my people would not hearken to my voice;  
and Israel would none of me. <sup>12</sup> So I gave them up unto their own hearts' lust: *and*  
they walked in their own counsels. <sup>13</sup> **Oh that my people** had hearkened unto me,

*and* Israel had walked in my ways! <sup>14</sup> **I should soon have** subdued their enemies, and turned my hand against their adversaries. <sup>15</sup> The haters of the LORD should have submitted themselves unto him: but their time should have endured for ever. <sup>16</sup> **He should have fed them also with the finest of the wheat: and with honey out of the rock should I have satisfied thee.**
